elcome to the National and International Forum on Quality in Healthcare and Second Latin American Forum on Quality and Safety in Healthcare "Best Global Practices to Achieve Value Outcomes". In order to provide useful elements to be implemented in your organizations, we have prepared an agenda with the highest national and international academic levels; we hope this experience provides you with great benefits for your personal and professional development as well as for your organizations.

We will start with an Opening Ceremony, where the National Quality of Healthcare Prize and the Recognition of Merit for Continuous Improvement will be awarded, in the presence of the Mexican Minister of Health, Dr. José Narro Robles. Similarly, the best posters registered for the current edition of the Forum will be awarded, as an incentive to generate and spread evidence in terms of Quality Improvement in Healthcare.

Our first academic activity will start with the opening conference held by Mr. Donald M. Berwick, President Emeritus and Senior Fellow of the Institute for Healthcare Improvement (IHI). He will speak about the Triple Aim and the improvement science (back to basics to construct the future), this will help us to focus on the five Value Outcomes of the Quality Management Model that the Ministry of Health promotes as goals to be achieved by the National Health System: Population health; Effective access; Safe and trustworthy organizations; Satisfactory and quality-transit experiences through the system; and Reasonable costs.

During the three-day Forum, we will have seven Keynote lectures and participation of more than 40 national and international speakers, representing 9 different countries and institutions, such as Argentina, Brazil, Ecuador, Scotland, United States of America, Japan, United Kingdom and 11 institutions of the Mexican Health System.

To provide continuity to the last two Forums, this year we will deeply address the Value Outcomes of the Quality Management Model, focusing on best global practices in priority topics in our country, Latin-America, and worldwide, such as breast cancer, cervical cancer, adolescent and child cancer, palliative care, as well as approaching chronicity care, best practices in labor and delivery care, acute myocardial infarction, and mental health. We have also selected cross-cutting issues, such as responding appropriately to serious adverse events, measuring quality improvement and developing evidence-based indicators, among others.

The shared challenge implies to generate value outcomes under complex financial environments, meaning establishing ambitious agendas that allow us to improve quality and decrease waste in our healthcare environment.

We will close the event with the participation of the Mexican race driver Guillermo Rojas, who is well known for his national and international motor racing. We will know his experiences focused on success and working in multidisciplinary high performance teams, showing the importance of adaptability to reach value outcomes, from a personal perspective aspiring triumph.

A great experience is about to begin, and we hope this will allow us to reflect on the conditions where health institutions, in a global scale, face very similar challenges, and how they can overcome them with solidarity and team spirit, which can be built through the commitment of us all, as health professionals dedicated to the improvement of quality of healthcare in our health organizations.
